

Beacon Roads Cycling Club Data Protection and Privacy Policy

Persons joining the Club, renewing membership or entering events promoted by the Club consent to the club collecting, storing and using personal data as described in this Policy.

The Club will use data provided by Members of the Club for the purposes of maintaining membership and financial records; administering any Club events or activities; dealing with any incidents during any Club events or activities; informing members about local cycling events or activities whether or not organised by the Club; and creating anonymous aggregated information about membership. The Club will use data provided by persons who are not members of the Club but who enter Club events for the purpose of administering those events.

The Club is not responsible for any personal data which is held by a third party organisation (including but not limited to British Cycling, Cycling UK, Cycling Time Trials or Audax UK) as a result of any person joining the Club or entering any event promoted by the Club via a system provided by such an organisation.

The Club will handle personal data in a manner that ensures appropriate security including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, disclosure or alteration.

The Club does not participate in any marketing activities involving personal data of members or persons entering Club events and will not pass on data to third parties for any reason without consent.

The Club is not responsible for any personal data which any individual discloses by posting on the Club Internet forum "Message Board" or social media sites.

The Club may record the events and rides which it promotes and these images may be published on the Club's web site, in social media, in online image galleries or in other media. If you do not wish your images to be used you should inform a member of the Committee or, where applicable, the event organiser in writing.

Persons who have provided their personal data to the Club are entitled to a copy of their personal data which is held by the Club. For details of how to do this contact the Membership Secretary, the Club Secretary or the Treasurer via the links on the Club website. Any corrections to personal data may also be submitted to any of these officials.

Upon resigning membership or choosing not to renew membership, former members may request immediate deletion of all their personal data by contacting the Membership Secretary, the Club Secretary or the Treasurer. Unless earlier deletion is requested, personal data is retained until the end of the calendar year following expiry of membership and following this date name and date of last subscription payment date is retained. Unless earlier deletion is requested personal data provided by non-members who enter an event or activity promoted by the Club until after the same event during the following year.
