## Congratulations

Sixty years after the first Beacon Mountain Time Trial we once again enjoyed an exciting cycling contest on the diverse roads of rural Worcestershire amongst the fresh spring greenery. The weather was largely kind, being mild and with very little wind although some showers during the morning gave many riders a wetting and made some of the corners rather slippery.

At last the top honour went to Matt Bottrill (De Rosa/MG Decor RT) on his third attempt. Previously he had had to be content to be runner-up to two national champions in Stuart Dangerfield (2004) and Gethin Butler (2007). Bottrill powered round the course in 1.39.06 and in doing so overcame two former Little Mountain Champions. Second placed Gavin Poupart (Echelon-SPIUK) won the event in 2006 and knows this course well having been placed highly in the results every year since 2004. His time of 1.39.33 was a personal improvement of 33 seconds and was exactly a minute ahead of Bill Moore (Shorter-Rochford RT) who took the win a decade ago, back in 1997 and 1998.

In the women's competition Michelle Parsons (Evesham Wheelers) returned this year to break the 2-hour mark with a very strong 1.58.00, so claiming the women's first place. Behind her, Lindsay Smith (Birmingham R&TC) shaved 42 seconds off her previous best and came tantalisingly close to 2 hours with 2.00.05. In third place for the women, newcomer to time trialling Trudi Sammons (Reading CC) made her long journey from Wokingham worthwhile with a remarkable debut ride of 2.01.33.

Out of 110 starters 45 riders opted for road bikes and contested the Roadman category. Highest placed of these and 10<sup>th</sup> overall was mountain-biker, road and track racer, Paul Bailey (Geoff Thomas Foundation) who was, incredibly, riding his first ever open time trial and hence was only given a place on the reserve list. Behind Paul in the Roadman competition was Flavio Zappi (Oxford University CC), who came all the way from Oxford without his cycling shoes and was very lucky to borrow a spare pair at the last minute. Tim Ashton (Royal Sutton CC) was the third placed Roadman.

In the vets categories the MI Racing – THULE team showed their huge strength amongst the older age groups. Jamie Burrell and Tony Taylor both of MI Racing – THULE took the V40 and V60 but it was in the V50 and V70 categories where some exciting events unfolded in the battle for the Course Record bonuses. One of the first home was Michael Amery (VC Sevale) in 1.50.59, taking over a minute off his personal best and claiming the V50 Record. Amery then endured an anxious wait while the rest of the times came in, only to see the record taken again by Tauny Southwood (Birmingham R&TC) with 1.50.46. In the V70 category Hugh McGuire (Beacon Roads CC) received congratulations on his 2.13.20 which was over 3 minutes faster than John Bevan's previous record. However, Bevan (MI Racing – THULE) had the perfect answer and reclaimed the record 35 minutes later with 2.12.44.

The team award was taken for the second year in succession by the Wyre Forest CRC. Their winning team included Paul Prince, Mark West and Brian Austin. Tim Ashton cleaned up in the PB Improvement category with an emphatic improvement of over 20 minutes and 2002 Winner, James Gilfillan (Primera-Bournemouth) was the fastest to climb the hills with a combined time of 07.24.

The 2007 Tour of Britain went up the climb of Ankerdine on Stage 3 (Worcester to Wolverhampton). The time taken by the leading break of eight riders, measured in the same way as for our event, was 3.11. The fastest time ever recorded in the Little Mountain was by Stuart Dangerfield in 2000 with a time of 3.12.
