## Congratulations

When the fledgling Beacon Roads Cycling Club hatched a plan to organise a mountain time trial in 1948 they wanted to make it the toughest possible race. Even though our course is shorter these days I think our event in 2012 fulfilled many of the criteria set by those pioneers. Every one of the 63 starters in Great Witley knew that they faced a battle with the elements, with the wind, cold and wet, in addition to all the usual challenges of such a hilly course. Many of those who did not finish cited the extreme cold as being the reason they pulled in at the HQ after the first lap and those who did complete the whole course faced a hard task to regain some warmth in their aching, frozen limbs. If we had had medals to go round, all finishers would have deserved one and all riders can be very pleased with themselves for getting out there, embracing the conditions and ensuring that the race was highly competitive with every prize hard-won.



Several observers commented on the focus and determination of 2009 Rudy Project Series winner Dean Robson (Somerset RC) and on the fact that he appeared to almost enjoy the conditions. This attitude undoubtedly contributed to his incredible ride in 1.45.52, only just over a minute slower than he achieved in 2010 when he came third. Top all-rounder Danny Axford (Arctic-SRAM RT) returned for the second time this year and produced a very impressive time of 1.51.08 on a road bike, claiming the prize for the fastest ascents of the hills as he did so. Last year's winner, Matt Clinton (MikeVaughan.co.uk) completed the men's podium with a time of 1.52.43.

The women who made it to the start line were obviously a hardy bunch because all finished and first-time entrant Stacey Penn (Team Jewson – MI Racing) scored a narrow victory over Louise Robinson representing Islabikes. Penn, who has twice won bronze at the World Triathlon Championships, completed the course in 2.20.03 while elite cyclocross rider and current National Masters Champion Robinson was just 9 seconds back on 2.20.12. However, Robinson rode a road bike and had the consolation of picking up both the Roadwoman prize and the hill-climbs prize for the women.

It was a family day out for Robinson with her sister spectating and her niece and nephew also braving the elements: Rebecca Womersley (Aire Valley RT) did well to complete the course in 2.32.02 but her younger brother Jake (Sportscover Altura RT) came home as the first junior in 2.02.29. This is the best time achieved by a junior and so earns Jake a place on our course record table and the fact that he was the third-fastest on a road bike is testament to the quality of the ride in those conditions.



The team prize this year went to the Beacon's own riders, Steve Bull, Chris Hudson and Paddy Allaway who claimed the 9<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> places.

The weather was not conducive to personal bests but one rider did manage to buck the trend and go faster than the only other time he has ridden the event. Gary MacKintosh was initially disappointed to 'only' go 7mins 20sec faster than in 2010 but as first rider off he had a long wait to discover how impressive that improvement was. As already mentioned, Dean Robson came within 1.06 of his best and the other very impressive relative performance was by Steve Batsford (Team i.ride.co.uk) who was just 2.13 short of his previous best.

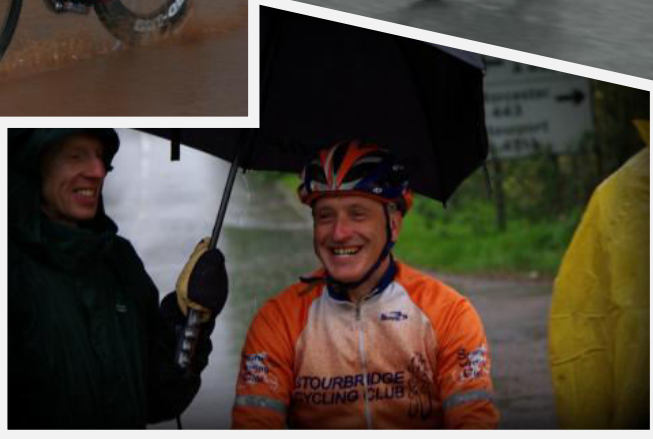
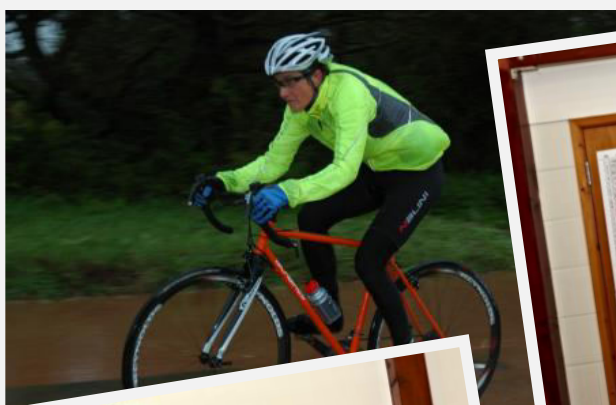
